- Follow-up from May 21 briefing at Fairlington Community Center
- I-395 Shirlington Road Interchange / Improvements Study
 - Identify Safety & Operational limits
 - Develop recommendations
 - Feedback from residents
- Study Status
 - Data collection
 - Feedback from government partners
 - Conceptual plans & alternatives
- Plans under consideration:
 - Alternative S-1: Reduce & Repurpose Existing Lanes
 - Alternative S-2: Realign Quaker Lane Ramp

- Alternative S-3: Add Lane to Arlington Mill Drive exit
- Alternative S-4: Create Signalized T-Intersection w/ Rotary & Quaker Lane
- Alternative S-5: Create Signalized Intersection w/ I-395 Offramp & Gunston Rd
- Alternative S-6: Create Signalized Intersection w/ I-395 Offramp & Campbell Ave
 - Resident comment: “Creating a stoplight where Quaker Lane accesses I-395 north will back traffic up”
- Two or more of these alternatives could be combined
 - Alternative G-1: (from S. Glebe to 395) Merge 2-lane west ramp to 1-lane
 - Alternative G-2: (from S. Glebe to 395) Shift west ramp to shoulder
 - Resident comment: “Can VDOT address bad sightlines here?”
- General Improvements
- Schedule & Funding
 - \$1.6M allocated for cost of study
- Next Steps

Resident Q&A

- Will VDOT address intersection of S. Glebe / West Glebe / I-395?
 - That is under consideration separately, based on previous questions
- No need to force Arlington Mill right lane to turn right into Shirlington; make the turn into Shirlington optional, so that more cars could continue onto I-395 South
 - We have heard this, especially regarding lack of observance of Yield signs
 - Many conflicts between buses and cars
- Could we make the circle return to I-395N a serpentine?
- Quaker Lane traffic flow in morning rush is greater than Circle flow
- Could we extend the Quaker Lane merge area, effectively starting the merge further uphill?
 - Yes, based on previous resident comments, we are considering better yield options
- Is it possible to eliminate right hand turn from Gunston Rd?
 - Local governments and residents objected to this idea
- Are there currently any funds devoted to this project right now?
 - No, other than minor fixes
- Will there be any concrete repair and maintenance on rotary itself?
 - Yes
